

Chief Master Sergeant Julia A. Andujar is the Senior Enlisted Leader for the Defense Health Agency's Medical Education and Training Campus (METC) located on Joint Base San Antonio-Fort Sam Houston in San Antonio, Texas. Chief Andujar is the primary enlisted adviser to the Commandant of the Department of Defense's largest allied healthcare campus entrusted with training the world's finest enlisted medical professionals.
