Colonel David C. Walmsley is Commandant of the Defense Health Agency's Medical Education and Training Campus, located on Joint Base San Antonio-Fort Sam Houston, Texas. He is responsible for the enlisted medical training of approximately 16,500 Army, Navy, Air Force and Coast Guard personnel a year in 48 programs of instruction.

Prior to that, Colonel Walmsley served as the Commander, 59th Training Group, Joint Base San Antonio-Fort Sam Houston. His other assignments included Deputy Commander of the 959th Medical Group where he was dual hatted as the Chief of Quality Services at Brook Army Medical Center, the DoD's largest MTF and sole Level I Trauma Center. He also commanded the 20th Medical Support Squadron and 2d Medical Operations Squadron and has worked on the Market Director's staff for the San Antonio Military Health System and National Capital Region Medical Directorate.
